Role of the P&C Association

The PRSS principal is the site manager and the Minister's representative. The P&C Association's role is to work closely with the principal and the school community in a productive partnership, to achieve the best possible outcomes for the school's students. The P&C Association does not intervene in the daily running of the school, which is the principal's responsibility. The principal's supervisor (Assistant Regional Director) is responsible for the principal's performance.²





Key Functions of the PRSS P&C Association are:

- To provide advice and recommendations to the school's principal on issues and concerns regarding students, and the general operation and management of the school
- To provide or assist in the provision of financial or other resources for the benefits of students of the school
- To foster community interest in educational matters
- To encourage closer cooperation between parents, other members of the community, staff and students of the school
- To communicate or respond to matters when/if required (ie. with local Government representatives, media or others) while maintaining political neutrality
- To perform any other functions, consistent with the Act, as the Minister may decide³
