It is not the role of the P&C Association to interfere in the daily running of the school, which is the role of the principal. The principal's supervisor is the DETE Assistant Regional Director. The principal will ask the P&C Association to endorse various documents during the course of the year.


Functions of the P&C Association (from the P&C Model Constitution)

- To foster community interest in educational matters
- To encourage closer cooperation between the parents of students attending the school, other members of the community, staff and students of the school.
- To provide advice and recommendations to the principal of the school on issues and concerns in respect of students and the general operation and management of the school.
- To provide or assist in the provision of financial or other resources or services for the benefit of students of the school.
- To perform any other functions, not inconsistent with the Act, as the Minister may decide. P&C Guide – Queensland Government.

2 Names! Payne Road State School was originally called "The Gap South State School" and commenced on the 26th January 1970. Our first Principal "Clive Cook" had the name changed to Payne Road State School before the official opening on the 7th November 1970.

2 Logos! You can still see the original logo around the school today. The older children have this logo on their bags, uniforms and hats. With another logo floating around on our signs and stationery (documents show this new logo existed for the Silver Jubilee in 1995), we made it a mission last year to change all uniforms, bags, hats and school marketing to be in line with the new logo, this will slowly phase the original logo out.
