The Payne Road Outside School Hours Care Program, will be operating an **Autumn Vacation Care Program** from Tuesday 3 April to Friday 13 April 2018.

To secure your child's place please follow the steps below:

1. Complete the attached enrolment form including the signed parent declaration
2. Return the enrolment form with full payment* (please contact us if we can be of assistance in working out your fees)
3. Ensure your child/ren are registered with **Centrelink (please contact us if more information is required)

Bookings are essential to ensure correct staff: child ratios are met and places may be limited.

Please note that your child's booking is not confirmed until the enrolment form and payment is received. NB: Payments received in advance may attract discount.

Payment can be made by eftpos, credit card or direct deposit.
